



Six Bridges Brewing | John's Creek, Georgia

Axis was hired by Six Bridges Brewing to convert a former warehouse/office location to a 10-barrel brewery with tasting room and event space. The 11,679 square feet of space required for the new brewery was carved out of the existing 31,820-square-foot building. The resulting 5,000-barrel-per-year brewery features a 7,000-square-foot production area (eight fermentation tanks), an 1,800-square-foot tasting room, a 1,500-square-foot accessory storage area/mechanical rooms, office space, new restrooms, and an outdoor patio.

The front elevation was modified to accommodate a new entrance into the brewery. The brewery's personality is showcased with a décor that is rustic with a warehouse charm. The brewery, a new venture for the City of John's Creek, required new zoning to be adopted by the mayor and city council.
